(D) (B) AN ACTION FOR AN INJUNCTION UNDER THIS SECTION IS IN ADDITION TO, AND NOT INSTEAD OF, DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS TAKEN UNDER § 2-310 OF THE THIS SUBTITLE OR THE IMPOSITION OF CIVIL PENALTIES UNDER § 2-310.1 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

CHAPTER 185

(House Bill 235)

AN ACT concerning

Center for the Study of the Health Effects of Fire

FOR the purpose of creating a Center for the Study of the Health Effects of Fire, to be directed by the Chief Medical Examiner of the State; creating an Advisory Council to the Center; specifying the membership and appointment requirements for the Advisory Council; defining a term; authorizing the adoption of certain regulations under certain conditions; establishing certain duties of the Chief Medical Examiner, the Center, and the Advisory Council; requiring certain reports to the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene and the General Assembly; requiring that certain information be confidential; prohibiting the use of certain information in a civil or criminal action for certain purposes; and generally relating to the creation of a Center for the Study of the Health Effects of Fire and the Advisory Council.

BY adding to

Article - Health - General

Section 18-701 through 18-711, inclusive, to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 7. Center for the Study of the Health Effects of Fire"
