

(4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(D) THE SECRETARY MAY REMOVE A MEMBER FOR INCOMPETENCE OR MISCONDUCT.

(A) FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS, THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL ELECT A CHAIRPERSON.

(B) THE MANNER OF ELECTION OF THE CHAIRPERSON SHALL BE AS THE ADVISORY COUNCIL DETERMINES.

18-709.

(A) THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL DETERMINE THE TIMES AND PLACES OF ITS MEETINGS.

(B) A MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL:

(1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT

(2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STATE STANDARD TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL:

(1) REVIEW THE WORK OF THE CENTER;

(2) ADVISE THE DIRECTOR OF THE CENTER CONCERNING THE SCIENTIFIC EVALUATION OF THE INFORMATION COLLECTED BY THE CENTER;

(3) ASSIST THE CENTER IN SETTING PRIORITIES CONCERNING:

(i) CONCERNING ISSUES TO BE RESEARCHED; OR

(ii) SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED TO INDIVIDUALS EXPOSED TO THE FIRE ENVIRONMENT; AND

(4) BEGINNING ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 1989, SUBMIT AN ANNUAL AND

(4) SUBMIT NO LATER THAN JULY 1 OF EACH YEAR, A REPORT TO THE SECRETARY AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, SUBJECT TO § 2-312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THAT:
