CHAPTER 193

(House Bill 317)

AN ACT concerning

Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages

FOR the purpose of including Frederick County among the counties that require the alcoholic beverages licensees under their jurisdiction who sell alcoholic beverages to minors under certain circumstances to be subject to the county law and be brought before the County Board of License Commissioners rather than the State courts.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
Section 118(c)  
Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

(c) (1) This subsection applies only in the following counties:

- (i) Carroll County;
- (II) FREDERICK COUNTY;
- [(ii)] (III) Somerset County;
- [(iii)] (IV) Talbot County; and
- [(iv)] (V) Wicomico County.

(2) A licensee under the provisions of this article, or any of his employees, may not sell or furnish any alcoholic beverages, other than beer and light wine, at any time to a person under 21 years of age, or beer and light wine to any person not designated under § 2(t)(2) of this article, either for
