PARKING-SPACE BUILDING, STRUCTURE, WALL, OR OTHER IMMOVABLE OBJECT IN A MANNER THAT CLEARLY INDICATES TO A DRIVER THAT THE SPACE IS RESERVED FOR HANDICAPPED PERSONS.

- (2) (i) Except as provided in this paragraph, the bottom edge of the sign shall be at least 7 feet above the ground.
- (ii) If the sign is placed against a building, structure, or other location that does not obstruct vehicle or pedestrian traffic, the bottom edge of the sign shall be at least 6 feet and no more than 10 feet above the ground.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.

CHAPTER 204

(House Bill 509)

AN ACT concerning

Queen Anne's County - Orphans' Court Judges

FOR the purpose of allowing the Queen Anne's County Commissioners to determine compensation for Orphans' Court judges; altering certain provisions concerning travel expenses for Orphans' Court judges in Queen Anne's County; eliminating certain fixed figures concerning compensation and travel expenses; providing that this Act does not alter compensation during a judge's term; and generally relating to Orphans' Court judges in Queen Anne's County.
