- (r) (1) Each of the judges of the court for Queen Anne's County shall receive [an annual compensation of \$2,080. Each judge shall also receive an allowance for traveling expenses of \$520 annually, to be paid quarterly by the County Commissioners] A SALARY AS SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.
- (2) (I) EACH JUDGE SHALL RECEIVE AN ALLOWANCE FOR TRAVEL EXPENSES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE COUNTY BUDGET.
- (II) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL PAY QUARTERLY TO EACH JUDGE THE TRAVEL ALLOWANCE PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the Orphans' Court judges of Queen Anne's County in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the Orphans' Court judges of Queen Anne's County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION  $2\tau$  3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  $\overline{Ju}$ ly 1, 1988.
