

Article 1 - Public Local Laws of Maryland  
(1983 Edition and February, 1987 Supplement, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 1 - Allegany County

68-1.

THERE IS AN ALLEGANY COUNTY SALARY STUDY COMMISSION.

68-2.

(A) THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF 5 MEMBERS.

(B) THE COMMISSION SHALL BE COMPRISED AS FOLLOW:

(1) 1 MEMBER FROM THE ~~DEMOCRAT~~ DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF ALLEGANY COUNTY;

(2) 1 MEMBER FROM THE REPUBLICAN CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF ALLEGANY COUNTY;

(3) 1 MEMBER OF THE ALLEGANY COUNTY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE;

(4) 1 MEMBER OF THE FARM BUREAU OF ALLEGANY COUNTY; AND

(5) 1 MEMBER OF THE LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS OF ALLEGANY COUNTY.

(C) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL APPOINT THE COMMISSION MEMBERS.

(D) A MEMBER MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION, BUT IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS.

(E) FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS, THE COMMISSION SHALL ELECT A CHAIRMAN.

68-3.

(A) THE COMMISSION SHALL BE CONSTITUTED AND SHALL MEET PRIOR TO THE 1989 SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF EACH SESSION EVERY 4 YEARS THEREAFTER.

(B) THREE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION ARE A QUORUM.
