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(L) THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL SHALL ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN A REPOSITORY OF REPORTS FILED IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 14B OF THIS ARTICLE.

14B.

IF THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL OR THE LOCAL AUTHORITY HAVING JURISDICTION OVER FIRE INVESTIGATIONS DETERMINES THAT A CHIMNEY CONTRIBUTED TO THE CAUSE OF A FIRE, THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL OR THE LOCAL AUTHORITY HAVING JURISDICTION OVER FIRE INVESTIGATIONS SHALL FILE WITH THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL'S OFFICE A REPORT THAT IDENTIFIES THE CHIMNEY INVOLVED IN THE FIRE AS:

- (1) A LINED, MASONRY CHIMNEY;
- (2) AN UNLINED, MASONRY CHIMNEY; OR
- (3) A PREFABRICATED, METAL CHIMNEY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.

CHAPTER 214

(House Bill 751)

AN ACT concerning

St. Mary's County - Length of Service Award Program

FOR the purpose of authorizing the St. Mary's County Commissioners to establish a length of service award program for certain volunteer fire and rescue personnel in St. Mary's County; and deleting references to a retirement program for those personnel.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
