ARE CONCERNED, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, WITH INFANT MORTALITY SUCH AS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

- (I) THE MEDICAL PROFESSION.
- (II) THE LEGAL PROFESSION.
- (III) STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT.
- (IV) COUNTY BOARDS OF HEALTH.
- (V) MAJOR SOCIO-ECONOMIC AND ETHNIC GROUPS.
- (B) (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS 3 YEARS.
- (2) THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON JULY 1, 1988. THE TERMS OF ONE-THIRD OF THOSE MEMBERS END EACH YEAR.
- (3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

13-704.

- (A) FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS, THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL ELECT A CHAIRMAN AND A VICE CHAIRMAN.
- (B) THE MANNER OF ELECTION OF OFFICERS AND THEIR TERMS OF OFFICE SHALL BE AS THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL DETERMINES.
- (A) THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL MEET AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT IT DETERMINES.
 - (B) A MEMBER OF THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL:
 - (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT
- (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
- (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE SECRETARIAL, CONSULTANT, AND OTHER STAFF SERVICES TO THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL.
