

ARE CONCERNED, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, WITH INFANT MORTALITY SUCH AS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

- (I) THE MEDICAL PROFESSION.
- (II) THE LEGAL PROFESSION.
- (III) STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT.
- (IV) COUNTY BOARDS OF HEALTH.
- (V) MAJOR SOCIO-ECONOMIC AND ETHNIC GROUPS.

(B) (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS 3 YEARS.

(2) THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON JULY 1, 1988. THE TERMS OF ONE-THIRD OF THOSE MEMBERS END EACH YEAR.

(3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(A) FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS, THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL ELECT A CHAIRMAN AND A VICE CHAIRMAN.

(B) THE MANNER OF ELECTION OF OFFICERS AND THEIR TERMS OF OFFICE SHALL BE AS THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL DETERMINES.

13-705.

(A) THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL MEET AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT IT DETERMINES.

(B) A MEMBER OF THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL:

(1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT

(2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE SECRETARIAL, CONSULTANT, AND OTHER STAFF SERVICES TO THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL.
