

THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL:

(1) SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT ON ITS ACTIVITIES TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY;

(2) ADVISE THE DEPARTMENT ON:

(I) REDUCING INFANT MORTALITY;

(II) IMPROVING PRENATAL CARE AND REDUCING THE INCIDENCE OF LOW BIRTH WEIGHT BABIES; AND

(III) ANY OTHER MATTERS THAT RELATE TO INFANT MORTALITY;

(3) ADVISE THE ADMINISTRATION AND THE GOVERNOR ON SPENDING FUNDS UNDER STATE AND FEDERAL LAWS THAT RELATE TO PRENATAL CARE AND REDUCING INFANT MORTALITY; AND

(4) BE A STRONG ADVOCATE OF A COMPREHENSIVE, BROAD-BASED APPROACH TO THE SOCIAL, ECONOMIC, AND MEDICAL PROBLEMS OF INFANT MORTALITY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.

CHAPTER 229

(House Bill 1170)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore City - Primary Elections - Alteration of Date for 1991

FOR the purpose of changing the date of the primary election to be held in 1991 for municipal offices in Baltimore City.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That, notwithstanding the provisions of Article 33, § 5-2(b) of the Annotated Code of Maryland, the day for holding primary elections for municipal offices in Baltimore City in 1991 shall be on the second Thursday after the first Monday in September, 1991.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
