

(2) TO DEVELOP, FOR PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SECTOR PARTICIPATION, ALTERNATIVE WAYS AND MEANS TO FINANCE AND EXPAND EXISTING SERVICES AND PROGRAMS FOR THE DISABLED.

(B) (1) THERE IS A REHABILITATION AND EMPLOYMENT ADVISORY COMMISSION WITHIN THE DIVISION OF VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION OF THE DEPARTMENT.

(2) THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF:

(I) 1 MEMBER OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE, AND 1 MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES, APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE;

(II) THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS OR THE SUPERINTENDENT'S DESIGNEE;

(III) THE ASSISTANT STATE SUPERINTENDENT FOR THE DIVISION OF VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION;

(IV) THE DIRECTOR OF THE MENTAL HYGIENE ADMINISTRATION OR THE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE;

(V) THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES ADMINISTRATION OR THE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE;

(VII) 2 REPRESENTATIVES OF CONSUMERS RECEIVING REHABILITATION SERVICES, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR;

~~{VI}~~ (VIII) 2---REPRESENTATIVES---FROM 1 REPRESENTATIVE EACH FROM 2 DIFFERENT ADVOCACY ORGANIZATIONS FOR THE DISABLED, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR;

(3) THE GOVERNOR SHALL DESIGNATE THE CHAIRMAN FROM AMONG THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMISSION.
