A FREE ASSOCIATION, SCHOOL, COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY LIBRARY IN THIS STATE SHALL DENY INSPECTION OF A ANY CIRCULATION RECORD OR OTHER ITEM, COLLECTION, OR GROUPING OF INFORMATION ABOUT AN INDIVIDUAL THAT:

(1) IS MAINTAINED BY A LIBRARY;

- (2) CONTAINS AN INDIVIDUAL'S NAME OR THE IDENTIFYING NUMBER, SYMBOL, OR OTHER IDENTIFYING PARTICULAR ASSIGNED TO THE INDIVIDUAL; AND
- (3) IDENTIFIES THE USE A PATRON MAKES OF THAT LIBRARY'S MATERIALS, SERVICES, OR FACILITIES. THAT-HENTHES-THE TRANSACTIONS-OF-A-BORROWER.

Article - State Government

10-616.

- (a) Unless otherwise provided by law, a custodian shall deny inspection of a public record, as provided in this section.
- (e) A custodian shall deny inspection of a circulation record of a public library that-identifies-the-transactions-of--a borrower. OR OTHER ITEM, COLLECTION, OR GROUPING OF INFORMATION ABOUT AN INDIVIDUAL THAT:

(1) IS MAINTAINED BY A LIBRARY;

- (2) CONTAINS AN INDIVIDUAL'S NAME OR THE IDENTIFYING NUMBER, SYMBOL, OR OTHER IDENTIFYING PARTICULAR ASSIGNED TO THE INDIVIDUAL; AND
- (3) IDENTIFIES THE USE A PATRON MAKES OF THAT LIBRARY'S MATERIALS, SERVICES, OR FACILITIES.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
