

A FREE ASSOCIATION, SCHOOL, COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY LIBRARY IN THIS STATE SHALL DENY INSPECTION OF A ANY CIRCULATION RECORD OR OTHER ITEM, COLLECTION, OR GROUPING OF INFORMATION ABOUT AN INDIVIDUAL THAT:

(1) IS MAINTAINED BY A LIBRARY;

(2) CONTAINS AN INDIVIDUAL'S NAME OR THE IDENTIFYING NUMBER, SYMBOL, OR OTHER IDENTIFYING PARTICULAR ASSIGNED TO THE INDIVIDUAL; AND

(3) IDENTIFIES THE USE A PATRON MAKES OF THAT LIBRARY'S MATERIALS, SERVICES, OR FACILITIES. ~~THAT IDENTIFIES THE TRANSACTIONS OF A BORROWER.~~

Article - State Government

10-616.

(a) Unless otherwise provided by law, a custodian shall deny inspection of a public record, as provided in this section.

(e) A custodian shall deny inspection of a circulation record of a public library ~~that identifies the transactions of a borrower.~~ OR OTHER ITEM, COLLECTION, OR GROUPING OF INFORMATION ABOUT AN INDIVIDUAL THAT:

(1) IS MAINTAINED BY A LIBRARY;

(2) CONTAINS AN INDIVIDUAL'S NAME OR THE IDENTIFYING NUMBER, SYMBOL, OR OTHER IDENTIFYING PARTICULAR ASSIGNED TO THE INDIVIDUAL; AND

(3) IDENTIFIES THE USE A PATRON MAKES OF THAT LIBRARY'S MATERIALS, SERVICES, OR FACILITIES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
