

(II) DEVELOP AND SUBMIT TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY RECOMMENDATIONS AS TO THESE PROJECTS, WHICH SHALL BE CONSISTENT WITH THE PLAN PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SECTION.

(4) IN SUBMITTING RECOMMENDATIONS PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE COMMISSION SHALL COMMENT ON THE OVERALL LEVEL OF FUNDING FOR HIGHER EDUCATION AND MAY COMMENT REGARDING FUNDING PRIORITIES AMONG SEGMENTS OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND, WITHIN PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION, AMONG INSTITUTIONS. IN REVIEWING THE VARIOUS BUDGETS AND SUBMITTING RECOMMENDATIONS THEREON, THE COMMISSION:

(I) MAY NOT REQUIRE, OF ANY SEGMENT OR INSTITUTION, A DETAILED BUDGET PRESENTATION THAT TENDS TO DUPLICATE OTHER PRESENTATIONS REQUIRED IN THE BUDGET PROCESS; AND

(II) AS TO THE FUNDING PRIORITY OF ANY INSTITUTION, MAY COMMENT ONLY ON THE ENTITY AS A WHOLE AND NOT ON ANY SEPARATE UNIT OF THE INSTITUTION.

(4)-(1)--THE GOVERNOR--SHALL--INCLUDE--IN--THE--ANNUAL BUDGET--SUBMISSION FOR FISCAL YEAR 1990 AN AMOUNT OF GENERAL FUND STATE SUPPORT FOR EACH PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION EQUAL TO AT LEAST THE GREATER OF:

1.--THE MOST RECENT GUIDELINE AMOUNT SET FOR THE INSTITUTION BY THE COMMISSION OR THE STATE BOARD FOR HIGHER EDUCATION UTILIZING THE FISCAL YEAR 1989 CRITERIA AND METHODOLOGY SET BY THE STATE BOARD FOR HIGHER EDUCATION;

2.--THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED TO THE INSTITUTION IN FISCAL YEAR 1989, ADJUSTED TO INCLUDE ANY TRANSFERS RELATED TO EMPLOYEES' COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENTS AND THE ANNUAL SALARY REVIEW; AND

3.--THE GUIDELINE AMOUNT SET BY THE STATE BOARD FOR HIGHER EDUCATION FOR THE INSTITUTION FOR FISCAL YEAR 1989.

(5) (I) THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET SUBMISSION FOR FISCAL YEAR 1990 AN AMOUNT OF GENERAL FUND STATE SUPPORT FOR EACH PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION EQUAL TO AT LEAST THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS:
