(A) (1) THE COMMISSION SHALL ESTABLISH:

- (I) A FACULTY ADVISORY COUNCIL;
- (II) A STUDENT ADVISORY COUNCIL;
- (III) A SEGMENTAL ADVISORY COUNCIL; AND
- (IV) A FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE ADVISORY COUNCIL.

(2) THESE COUNCILS SHALL MEET PERIODICALLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF REVIEWING SUCH MATTERS AS ARE REFERRED BY THE COMMISSION OR THE COMMISSIONER SECRETARY FOR THEIR CONSIDERATION AND ADVICE.

(3) THE COUNCILS MAY MAKE REPORTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE COMMISSION.

(B) (1) THE COMMISSION MAY APPOINT CONTINUING ADVISORY COMMITTEES THAT REPRESENT VARIOUS GROUPS IN THE HIGHER EDUCATION COMMUNITY.

(2) ADVISORY COMMITTEES MAY MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE COMMISSION ON MATTERS OF STATEWIDE IMPORTANCE THAT AFFECT THEIR CONSTITUENCIES.

(A) THE COMMISSION MAY AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSIONER SECRETARY, ACTING THROUGH THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, TO SEEK AN INJUNCTION OR OTHER JUDICIAL REMEDY FOR ANY VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE OR OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS TITLE.

(B) THE COMMISSIONER SECRETARY MAY REQUIRE ANY POSTSECONDARY-NONDEGREE-GRANTING-PROPRIETARY-INSTITUTION PRIVATE CAREER SCHOOL OFFERING UNAPPROVED PROGRAMS TO REFUND ALL TUITION AND FEES PAID BY STUDENTS WHO ENROLLED IN SUCH PROGRAMS, AND MAY REVOKE THE CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL OF ANY POSTSECONDARY-NONDEGREE GRANTING-PROPRIETARY-INSTITUTION PRIVATE CAREER SCHOOL THAT FAILS
