LAWS OF MARYLAND

(I) A HEARING IS NOT REQUESTED; OR

- (II) AFTER THE HEARING, THE COMMISSION DETERMINES THAT THE INSTITUTION DID NOT CORRECT THE DEFICIENCIES WITHIN THE PERIOD SET BY THE COMMISSION.
- (2) THE ORDER TAKES EFFECT 15 DAYS AFTER IT IS ISSUED.
- (D) (1) AN INSTITUTION THAT IS AGGRIEVED BY AN ORDER OF THE COMMISSION HAS THE RIGHT TO JUDICIAL REVIEW PROVIDED BY TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 2 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
- (2) THE DECISION OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE PRESUMED CORRECT AND THE INSTITUTION HAS THE BURDEN OF PROVING OTHERWISE.
- (3) THE COMMISSION SHALL BE A PARTY TO THE PROCEEDING.

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- (A) (1) AT-beast-180-bays prior to the proposed date of implementation, the governing board body of an institution of postsecondary education shall submit to the commission each proposal for:
 - (I) A NEW PROGRAM; OR
- (II) À SUBSTANTIAL MODIFICATION OF AN EXISTING PROGRAM.
- (2) THE COMMISSION SHALL REVIEW EACH SUCH PROPOSAL AND:
- (I) WITH RESPECT TO EACH PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION, EITHER APPROVE OR DISAPPROVE THE PROPOSAL:
- (II) WITH RESPECT TO EACH INDEPENDENT NONPUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION; EITHER RECOMMEND THAT THE PROPOSAL BE IMPLEMENTED OR THAT THE PROPOSAL NOT BE IMPLEMENTED; AND
- (III) WITH RESPECT TO A POSTSECONDARY-NONDEGREE GRANTING-PROPRIETARY-INSTITUTION PRIVATE CAREER SCHOOL, EITHER APPROVE OR DISAPPROVE THE PROPOSAL.
- (3) IF THE COMMISSION FAILS TO ACT WITHIN 150 DAYS OF THE DATE OF SUBMISSION OF THE COMPLETED PROPOSAL, THE PROPOSAL SHALL BE DEEMED APPROVED.
