POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION AND POSTSECONDARY-NONDEGREE--GRANTING PROPRIETARY-INSTITUTION PRIVATE CAREER SCHOOL MAY NOT IMPLEMENT A PROPOSAL WITHOUT THE PRIOR APPROVAL OF THE COMMISSION.

- (5) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION—(A) PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SECTION SUBSECTION, AND SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF \$-17-104(A) 5 17-105 OF THIS ARTICLE, AN-INDEPENDENT A NONPUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION MAY IMPLEMENT A PROPOSAL THAT HAS NOT RECEIVED A POSITIVE RECOMMENDATION BY THE COMMISSION.
- COMMISSION SHALL PROVIDE TO THE GOVERNING BODY THAT SUBMITS THE PROPOSAL A WRITTEN EXPLANATION OF THE REASONS FOR THE DISAPPROVAL.
- COMMISSION'S REASONS FOR DISAPPROVAL, THE GOVERNING BODY MAY SUBMIT THE REVISED PROPOSAL TO THE COMMISSION FOR APPROVAL.
- (B) (1) PRIOR TO DISCONTINUATION, EACH INSTITUTION OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION THAT PROPOSES TO DISCONTINUE AN EXISTING PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE WRITTEN NOTIFICATION TO THE COMMISSION SPECIFYING:
 - (I) THE NAME OF THE PROGRAM; AND
 - (II) THE EXPECTED DATE OF DISCONTINUATION.
- (2) BY RULE OR REGULATION, THE COMMISSION MAY REQUIRE THE PAYMENT BY A POSTSECONDARY--NONDEGREE--GRANTING--PROPRIETARY INSTITUTION PRIVATE CAREER SCHOOL OF A REFUND TO ANY STUDENT OR ENROLLEE WHO, BECAUSE OF THE DISCONTINUATION OF AN ONGOING PROGRAM, IS UNABLE TO COMPLETE SUCH PROGRAM.
