- (A) (1) THE PRESIDENT OF EACH PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IS RESPONSIBLE FOR DEVELOPING A MISSION STATEMENT.
- (2) THE PRESIDENT SHALL SUBMIT THE MISSION STATEMENT TO THE INSTITUTION'S GOVERNING BOARD.
- PRESIDENT SHALL UPDATE THE MISSION STATEMENT AT LEAST EVERY 5 YEARS.
  - (B) (1) THE GOVERNING BOARD:
- REQUIRE THE PRESIDENT TO PREPARE A REVISED MISSION STATEMENT;
- MISSION STATEMENT AS SUBMITTED OR WITH AMENDMENTS; AND
- COMMISSION. (III) SHALL SUBMIT THE STATEMENT TO THE
- (2) (1) IN THE CASE OF CONSTITUENT INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SYSTEM, THE CHANCELLOR OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SYSTEM SHALL REVIEW THE STATEMENT PRIOR TO ITS CONSIDERATION BY THE BOARD OF REGENTS AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS.
