- [(b)] (A) There is a Maryland Fire-Rescue Education and Training Commission in the [State Board for] MARYLAND Higher Education COMMISSION.
- [(c)] (B) (1) The Commission consists of 13 members appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. Of the members:
- (i) Each shall be qualified to deal with the matters within the authority of the Commission;
- $(\mbox{ii})$  Six shall be volunteer emergency services personnel or instructors;
- (iii) Three shall be emergency services instructors who are career personnel representing the academies;
- (iv) Three shall be career emergency services personnel who are not instructors; and
- (v) One shall be a member of the general public.
- (2) Each member serves for a term of 4 years and until a successor is appointed and qualifies. These terms are staggered as required by the terms of the members serving on July 1, 1978.
- (3) A member appointed to fill a vacancy in an unexpired term serves only for the remainder of that term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
  - (4) A member may be removed by the Governor:
    - (i) For neglect of duty; or
- (ii) If he believes the member's continued membership is not in the public interest.
  - (5) Each member of the Commission:
    - (i) Serves without compensation; but
- (ii) Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses in accordance with the [Standard] State STANDARD Travel Regulations.
- [(d)] (C) (1) The Governor shall designate one of the members of the Commission as the chairman of the Commission. The chairman serves at the pleasure of the Governor.
- (2) Each year, the Commission shall elect a vice-chairman and any other officer it requires.
