

(2) UNLESS REESTABLISHED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THIS SUBTITLE AND ALL REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE SHALL TERMINATE AND BE OF NO EFFECT AFTER JULY 1, 1991 1992.

(B) (1) THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION SHALL:

(I) EVALUATE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE COLLEGE PREPARATION INTERVENTION PROGRAM; AND

(II) SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON OR BEFORE THE 20TH DAY OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR 1991.

(2) THE REPORT SHALL:

(I) CONTAIN THE RESULTS OF THE COMMISSION'S EVALUATION OF THE COLLEGE PREPARATION INTERVENTION PROGRAM; AND

(II) RECOMMEND WHETHER THE PROGRAM SHOULD BE REESTABLISHED, WITH OR WITHOUT CHANGES, OR ALLOWED TO TERMINATE.

TITLE 12. UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SYSTEM

SUBTITLE 1. POWERS AND DUTIES

12-101.

(A) IN ORDER TO FOSTER THE DEVELOPMENT OF A CONSOLIDATED SYSTEM OF PUBLIC HIGHER EDUCATION, TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF EDUCATION, TO EXTEND ITS BENEFITS AND TO ENCOURAGE THE ECONOMICAL USE OF THE STATE'S RESOURCES, THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SYSTEM IS ESTABLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE.

(B) IN THIS TITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(1) "BOARD" OR "BOARD OF REGENTS" MEANS THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SYSTEM;

(2) "CHANCELLOR" MEANS THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SYSTEM AND THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF STAFF FOR THE BOARD OF REGENTS;

(3) "PRESIDENT" MEANS THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF A CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SYSTEM;

(4) "CONSTITUENT INSTITUTIONS", "INSTITUTIONS" OR "CAMPUSES" MEANS THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS:

(I) UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND AT BALTIMORE;
