- (a) The government of Morgan State University is vested in the Board of Regents of Morgan State University.
- (b) The Board of Regents consists of 13 members appointed by the Governor <u>WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE</u>.
- (c) (1) Each member of the Board shall be a resident of this State.
- (2) One member shall be a student in good academic standing at the University who:
 - (i) Is at least 18 years old; and
- $\mbox{(ii)}$ Has the qualifications required to be student body president.
- (d) (1) Except for the student member, each member serves for a term of 6 years and until a successor is appointed and qualifies. The terms are staggered as required by the terms of the members serving on July 1, 1978.
- (2) The student member serves for a term of 1 year and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (3) A member appointed to fill a vacancy in an unexpired term serves only for the remainder of that term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
