- (D) (1) THE PRESIDENT SHALL DEVELOP AN OVERALL PLAN THAT IS CONSISTENT WITH THE STATEWIDE PLAN FOR HIGHER EDUCATION AND THE CHARTER THAT:
- GOALS, OBJECTIVES, AND PRIORITIES FOR, AND SERVICE PROVIDED BY ST. MARY'S COLLEGE AND METHODS AND GUIDELINES FOR ACHIEVING AND MAINTAINING THEM;
- (II) SUBJECT TO § 11-105 OF THIS ARTICLE, IDENTIFIES THE ROLE, FUNCTION, AND MISSION OF ST. MARY'S COLLEGE;
- (III) ENHANCES ITS ROLE AS A TRADITIONAL LIBERAL ARTS COLLEGE;
- (IV) AFFIRMS THE NEED FOR INCREASED ACCESS FOR ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTAGED AND MINORITY STUDENTS;
- (V) ENCOURAGES AND SUPPORTS HIGH QUALITY UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS; AND
- THE STATE THROUGH CLOSE RELATIONSHIPS WITH PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS, BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY, AND GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES.
- (2) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL REVIEW, MODIFY, AND APPROVE THE PLAN.
- (3) BY JULY 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL SUBMIT TO THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION, TO THE GOVERNOR AND, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AN ANNUAL REVIEW OF THE PLAN.
