- (a) The State-Scholarship-{Board} ADMINISTRATION COMMISSION ADMINISTRATION shall determine the amount of each general State scholarship based on the financial need of the applicant.
- (b) (1) A general State scholarship may be awarded in \$100 increments. However, the award for a single year may not be less than \$200 or more than \$2,500.
- (2) A recipient may not be awarded more than \$10,000 for undergraduate study.

18-304.

- (a) A general State scholarship may be used:
- (1) At a degree granting institution of higher education, an eligible institution with a terminal certificate program that provides transfer credit for an accredited baccalaureate program, or a hospital diploma school for training registered nurses if the curriculum is approved by the [State Board for Higher Education] COMMISSION; and
- (2) For educational expenses as defined by the [State Scholarship Board] COMMISSION, including:
 - (i) Tuition and fees; and
 - (ii) Room and board.
- (b) A general State scholarship may be used at a school in another state if:
- (1) There is a reciprocal agreement as provided in Section 18-308 18-307 of this subtitle; and
- (2) The school meets requirements of subsection (a)(1) of this section.
