- (1) An eligible institution for a program of undergraduate, graduate, or professional studies; and
- (2) An accredited undergraduate, graduate, or professional institution outside the State, if the applicant will be studying in an academic area that is not available in this State.

18-502.

Each member of the House of Delegates may select the recipients of the scholarships on any basis that the Delegate considers appropriate.

18-503.

- (a) During each term in office, each Delegate may award the equivalent of two FOUR 4-year full-time scholarships, which may be awarded for either 1, 2, 3, or 4 year periods.
- (b) (1) Each scholarship pays the tuition and mandatory fees at any eligible institution.
- (2) The annual amount of a scholarship at a private institution or any graduate or professional program may not exceed the equivalent annual tuition and mandatory fees of an undergraduate program at the University of Maryland.

18-504.

- (a) A Delegate may award 2 part-time scholarships for each full-time scholarship available.
- (b) A part-time scholarship may not be for more than twice as many years as a full-time scholarship.
- (c) Each recipient of a part-time scholarship shall carry at least 6 semester hours of courses each semester in a program leading to a degree.

18-505.

- (a) (1) Each recipient of a full-time Delegate Scholarship may use the scholarship to attend summer school.
- (2) The recipient shall request permission to attend summer school from the State-Scholarship--{Board} ADMINISTRATION EDMMISSION ADMINISTRATION at least 6 months before it starts.
- (b) The term of a full-time Delegate Scholarship shall be shortened by one-half year for each summer of use.
