

- (ii) Room and board; and
- (iii) Books and supplies; and

(2) May be used at any institution approved by the State--~~Scholarship~~--~~{Board}~~--ADMINISTRATION COMMISSION ADMINISTRATION including:

- (i) An institution of higher education;
- (ii) A vocational school;
- (iii) A commercial school; or
- (iv) A military preparatory school, if the child is preparing to attend one of the United States military academies.

(g) (1) The scholarship shall be paid on vouchers approved by the State--~~Scholarship~~--~~{Board}~~--ADMINISTRATION COMMISSION ADMINISTRATION.

(2) Room and board of a recipient who lives off-campus shall be paid on vouchers approved by the institution.

(h) The State--~~Scholarship~~--~~{Board}~~--ADMINISTRATION COMMISSION ADMINISTRATION:

- (1) May accept any gift or grant from any person for the Edward T. Conroy Scholarship Fund;
- (2) Shall use any gift or grant that it receives for the Program for aid to a needy student who is the recipient of a scholarship from the Program; and
- (3) Shall deposit any gift or grant that it receives for the Program with the State Treasurer in a nonbudgeted account.

(a) There is a program of scholarships that are awarded under this section.

(b) Any resident of this State may apply to the State ~~Scholarship~~--~~{Board}~~--ADMINISTRATION COMMISSION ADMINISTRATION under this section if he:

- (1) Was a prisoner of war on or after January 1, 1960 as a result of the Vietnam conflict; and
