- (i) Receive more than \$2,000 a year; and
- (ii) Be awarded more than two scholarships or the part-time equivalent.
- (2) An applicant for a graduate nursing student , as provided in this section, must meet the requirements for acceptance in a postbaccalaureate degree program in nursing.
- (3) Each scholarship may be used only for tuition and mandatory fees.
- the (4) In case of demonstrated need, State Scholarship Board may award additional amounts to cover:
 - (i) Room and board; and
 - (ii) Books and supplies.
- The scholarship shall be paid to the institution on vouchers approved by the State Scholarship Board.
- (e) Each recipient of a scholarship under this section may hold the scholarship until completion of the graduate nursing education program if the recipient:
 - (1) Continues to be a resident of this State; and
- (2) In the judgment of the institution, is making satisfactory progress toward completion of the program.
 - (f) Each year the State Scholarship Board shall:
- (1) Announce the availability and conditions of scholarships under this section at all appropriate places;
- (2) Give preference to applicants who demonstrate financial need:
- (3) Distribute scholarships available under section to qualified applicants meeting the requirements of this section:
- (4) Subject to § 2-1312 of the State Government Article, report to the General Assembly on or before November 1 number of applicants and the number of scholarship recipients.
- (q) If the recipient does not complete the nursing education program or fulfill the requirements of subsection (c)(3) of this section the recipient shall:
