- (b) Each applicant for a postsecondary-proprietary PRIVATE CAREER SCHOOL student grant shall:
- (1) Be accepted for admission at an approved private postsecondary-proprietary-institution CAREER SCHOOL;
- (2) Be enrolled in a full-time program as determined by the [State Board for] MARYLAND Higher Education COMMISSION;
 - (3) Be a resident of this State; and
- (4) Demonstrate to the State--Scholarship--{Board} ADMINISTRATION financial need.

18-1204.

A [postsecondary proprietary] PRIVATE CAREER SCHOOL student grant may be awarded in \$100 increments. However, AN award for a single year may not be more than \$1,500.

18-1205.

- A postsecondary--proprietary <u>PRIVATE CAREER SCHOOL</u> student grant may be used:
- (1) At a private postsecondary---proprietary institution CAREER SCHOOL in this State that:
- (i) Is approved by the [State Board of] MARYLAND Higher Education COMMISSION; and
 - (ii) Operates solely within the State; and
 - (2) For tuition charges only.

18-1206.

- Each recipient of a [postsecondary proprietary] PRIVATE CAREER SCHOOL student grant may hold the grant for 2 years if the student:
 - (1) Continues to be a resident of this State;
 - (2) Continues to be enrolled in a full-time program;
- satisfactory progress toward a certificate of completion; and
 - (4) Continues to demonstrate a financial need.
