

(1) PUBLIC OFFICERS AND PUBLIC AGENCIES OF THE STATE AND ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISION;

(2) BANKS, TRUST COMPANIES, SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATIONS, INVESTMENT COMPANIES, AND OTHERS CARRYING ON A BANKING BUSINESS;

(3) INSURANCE COMPANIES AND INSURANCE ASSOCIATIONS AND OTHERS CARRYING ON AN INSURANCE BUSINESS;

(4) ADMINISTRATORS, EXECUTORS, GUARDIANS, TRUSTEES, AND OTHER FIDUCIARIES; AND

(5) ALL OTHER PERSONS.

(B) THE BONDS ARE SECURITIES WHICH MAY PROPERLY AND LEGALLY BE DEPOSITED WITH AND RECEIVED BY ANY STATE OR MUNICIPAL OFFICE OR ANY AGENCY OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE FOR ANY PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE DEPOSIT OF BONDS OR OTHER OBLIGATIONS OF THE STATE IS NOW OR HEREAFTER AUTHORIZED BY LAW.

(A) THE TITLE TO ANY PROPERTY ACQUIRED OR CONSTRUCTED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE SHALL BE IN THE STATE OF MARYLAND FOR THE USE OF THE SYSTEM.

(B) THE STATE CONSENTS TO THE USE OF ANY LANDS OWNED BY IT FOR THE USE OF THE SYSTEM WHICH MAY BE SUITABLE AND NECESSARY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OR OPERATION OF ANY OF THE BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES AUTHORIZED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE AND COVENANTS THAT IT WILL NOT REVOKE THIS CONSENT DURING THE TERM OF BONDS SECURED BY FEES OF FACILITIES CONSTRUCTED THEREON.

THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE, BEING NECESSARY FOR THE WELFARE OF THE STATE AND ITS INHABITANTS, SHALL BE LIBERALLY CONSTRUED TO EFFECT THE PURPOSES THEREOF.

21-104.

In addition to any other power granted or duty imposed, the State Council on Vocational-Technical Education shall:

(7) Advise:

(i) The [State Board for] MARYLAND Higher Education COMMISSION in developing and evaluating vocational-technical programs, services, and facilities; and

(ii) The State Board for Community Colleges on vocational-technical programs, services, and activities;
