- THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE REQUIREMENTS THAT IGNITION INTERLOCK SYSTEMS:
- (I) DO NOT IMPEDE THE SAFE OPERATION OF THE VEHICLE;
 - (II) MINIMIZE OPPORTUNITIES TO BE BYPASSED;
- (III) CORRELATE ACCURATELY WITH ESTABLISHED MEASURES OF BLOOD ALCOHOL LEVELS:
- (IV) WORK ACCURATELY AND RELIABLY IN AN UNSUPERVISED ENVIRONMENT;
- REQUIRE A PROPER AND ACCURATE MEASURE OF BLOOD ALCOHOL LEVELS;
- (VI) RESIST TAMPERING AND PROVIDE EVIDENCE OF ATTEMPTED TAMPERING;
- (VII) ARE DIFFICULT TO CIRCUMVENT, AND REQUIRE PREMEDITATION TO CIRCUMVENT;
 - (VIII) MINIMIZE INCONVENIENCE TO A SOBER USER;
- (IX) ARE MANUFACTURED BY A PARTY RESPONSIBLE FOR INSTALLATION, USER TRAINING, SERVICE, AND MAINTENANCE;
- OPERATE RELIABLY OVER THE RANGE OF MOTOR VEHICLE ENVIRONMENTS OR MOTOR VEHICLE MANUFACTURING STANDARDS;
- (XI) ARE MANUFACTURED BY A PERSON WHO ADEQUATELY INSURED FOR PRODUCTS LIABILITY; AND
- (XII) PROVIDE THE OPTION FOR AN ELECTRONIC LOG OF THE DRIVER'S EXPERIENCE WITH THE SYSTEM.
- THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL DESIGN AND ADOPT (3) (I) WARNING LABEL TO BE AFFIXED TO AN IGNITION INTERLOCK SYSTEM ON INSTALLATION.
- THE WARNING LABEL SHALL (II)STATE THAT PERSON TAMPERING WITH, CIRCUMVENTING, OR OTHERWISE MISUSING IGNITION INTERLOCK SYSTEM IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR, AND, ON CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OR IMPRISONMENT OR BOTH.
- (4) (I) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL PUBLISH A LIST OF CERTIFIED IGNITION INTERLOCK SYSTEMS.
- (II) A MANUFACTURER OF AN IGNITION INTERLOCK SYSTEM THAT SEEKS TO SELL OR LEASE THE IGNITION INTERLOCK SYSTEM TO PERSONS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF § 27-107 OF THIS SUBTITLE
