- "VICTIM SERVICES COORDINATOR" MEANS THE PERSON WHO IS APPOINTED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF \$ 6.5-204 OF THIS TITLE.

THERE IS A STATE BOARD OF VICTIM SERVICES IN THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

- (A) (1) THE BOARD CONSISTS OF ±3 15 MEMBERS WHO SHALL SERVE WITHOUT COMPENSATION.
 - (2) THE BOARD SHALL CONSIST OF:
- THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OR THE ATTORNEY (I) GENERAL'S DESIGNEE, AS AN EX OFFICIO MEMBER, WHO SHALL BE CHAIRMAN:
- (II) 2 STATE'S ATTORNEYS, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR, ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL;
- (III) 3 MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR, ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL;
- (IV) 2 PROFESSIONAL VICTIM SERVICE PROVIDERS. APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR, ON RECOMMENDATION OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL;
- (V) THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE MARYLAND CRIMINAL INJURIES COMPENSATION BOARD;
