

(VI) 1 MEMBER OF THE JUDICIARY OF THE STATE, APPOINTED BY THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS;

(VII) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND STATE SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR;

(VIII) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND CHIEFS OF POLICE, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR; AND

(IX) THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE;

(X) THE DIRECTOR OF THE JUVENILE SERVICES AGENCY OR THE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE; AND

(XI) THE SECRETARY OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE.

(B) (1) THE TERM OF AN APPOINTED MEMBER IS 5 YEARS.

(2) THE TERMS OF APPOINTED MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD ON JULY 1, 1988.

(3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(C) THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE A MEMBER FOR INCOMPETENCE OR MISCONDUCT.

SUBJECT TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, THE BOARD SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING POWERS AND DUTIES:

(1) TO RENDER EACH YEAR TO THE ATTORNEY GENERAL A WRITTEN REPORT OF ITS ACTIVITIES;

(2) TO MONITOR SERVICE NEEDS OF VICTIMS;

(3) TO ADVISE THE ATTORNEY GENERAL ON THE NEEDS OF VICTIMS; AND

(4) (I) TO RECOMMEND THE APPOINTMENT OF THE VICTIM SERVICES COORDINATOR TO THE ATTORNEY GENERAL; AND

(II) TO REVIEW AND APPROVE VICTIM SERVICES COORDINATOR PLANS, ANNUAL REPORTS, AND THE IMPLEMENTATION,
