~~(2) A PERSON MAY NOT HIRE, SOLICIT, ENGAGE, OR USE A MINOR IN ANY MANNER, FOR THE PURPOSE OF MANUFACTURING ANY CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE, UNLESS THE MANUFACTURE HAS A LAWFUL PURPOSE.~~

(b) Any person who violates this section is guilty of a felony and, upon conviction, shall be sentenced to imprisonment for up to 10 years, or fined up to \$10,000, or both.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.

CHAPTER 260

(Senate Bill 53)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Dorchester County Jail Loan of 1988

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$5,000,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the County Commissioners of Dorchester County for the design, site improvement, construction, and equipping of a new Dorchester County jail, ~~and for the restoration, renovation, reconstruction, and equipping of the existing Dorchester County jail to be used for holding cells and support space,~~ subject to the requirement that the County Commissioners of Dorchester County provide at least an equal and matching fund of a certain kind for the same purpose by a certain date; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Dorchester County Jail Loan of 1988 in the total principal amount of \$5,000,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general
