

(I) PROMINENTLY PLACED;

(II) PRINTED IN AN OPEN TYPEFACE, SUCH AS HELVETICA, NO SMALLER THAN 10 POINTS; AND

(III) POSITIONED AND COLORED TO DISTINGUISH IT FROM INCOME TAX MATERIAL.

[(2)] (3) For income verification, the Comptroller shall:

(i) cooperate with the Department in adopting a procedure to audit the application forms; and

(ii) notwithstanding Article 81, § 300 of the Code, supply the Department with additional information.

[(3)](4) The Comptroller shall assist the Department in a post audit of each application.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.

CHAPTER 265

(Senate Bill 128)

AN ACT concerning

State Procurement - Nondiscrimination Requirements

FOR the purpose of prohibiting employment discrimination on the basis of age by contractors as a condition of qualification for State procurement contracts; providing for the termination of certain provisions of this Act; and providing for a delayed effective date for certain other provisions of this Act.
