SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 6-201 through 6-207, respectively, and the subtitle "Subtitle 2. Maryland Flammable Products Act" and 7-101 through 7-108, respectively, and the subtitle "Subtitle 1. Hazardous Materials" of Article - Environment of the Annotated Code of Maryland be transferred to be Section(s) 22-401 through 22-407, respectively, to be under the subtitle "Subtitle 4. Maryland Flammable Products Act" and 22-501 through 22-508, respectively, to be under the subtitle "Subtitle 5. Hazardous Materials" of Article - Health - General of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Environment

(b) (3) THE SECRETARY SHALL ESTABLISH THE GENERAL POLICY FOR AND ADOPT STANDARDS TO PROMOTE AND GUIDE THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES OF THIS THE STATE AND---ITS SUBDIVISIONS.

(4) THE SECRETARY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ENVIRONMENTAL INTERESTS OF THE PEOPLE OF THIS THE STATE AND SHALL SUPERVISE GENERALLY THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL LAWS OF THIS THE STATE AND-ITS-SUBDIVISIONS.
