- (1) file the security; or
- (2) submit a written request for a hearing on the security requirement.
- (e) (1) If a hearing is requested, the county shall hold a hearing to determine the necessity, propriety, and amount of the security.
- (2) The determination at the hearing is final, and the hotel shall comply within 15 days after the hotel receives notice of the determination.
- (f) Without notice to the hotel that files security under subsection (e) (B)(2) [of] OR (3) of this section, the county at any time may:
  - (1) apply the cash to the hotel rental tax due; or
- (2) sell the security and apply the proceeds of the sale to the hotel rental tax due.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988 and shall remain effective until January 1, 1989. On January 1, 1989, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, Section 1 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect, so that the provisions of Article 81, § 411F are repealed in accordance with Chapter (S.B. 2) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1988, effective January 1, 1989.
- SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take effect January 1, 1989.

## CHAPTER 318

(Senate Bill 552)

AN ACT concerning

Regional Planning Council - Members and Staff

FOR the purpose of altering the ex officio membership of the Regional Planning Council to include the Secretary of the Department of Economic and Employment Development, the Secretary of the Department of the Environment, and the
