- (ii) Any other of its highway activities, including lighting the highways and providing storm water drainage;
- (5) The cost of transportation facilities, as defined in § 3-101 of this article; [or]
 - (6) As to Kent County, costs for:
- (i) Maintenance of county owned boat landings; and
- (ii) Costs incurred in providing traffic crossing guards; OR
- (7) AS TO BALTIMORE CITY, FOR FISCAL YEARS 1989 THROUGH-1992-ONLY AND 1990, STUDENTS' COSTS OF DISCOUNTED -MTA-MASS TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION FARES FOR ELIGIBLE PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS IN BALTIMORE CITY.
