

- (2) a member of the Senate appointed by the President of the Senate;
- (3) a member of the House of Delegates appointed by the Speaker of the House;
- (4) the Comptroller;
- (5) the Treasurer WHO MAY APPOINT, AS THE TREASURER'S DESIGNEE, THE A DEPUTY TREASURER;
- (6) the Secretary of General Services;
- (7) the President of the Johns Hopkins University or a designee;
- (8) the President of the Maryland Historical Society;
- (9) the President of the St. John's College or a designee;
- (10) the President of the University of Maryland or a designee; and
- (11) the President of the Morgan State University or a designee.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.

(Senate Bill 569)

AN ACT concerning

Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation -
Board of Trustees

FOR the purpose of authorizing a person to be appointed to and serve on the Board of Trustees of the Maryland Agricultural Land Foundation who has sold certain agricultural easements to the Foundation at a certain time.
