 - (I) ILLNESS;
 - (II) VACATIONS; OR
 - (III) ANY OTHER REASONABLE CAUSE.
- (3) (4) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL GIVE NOTICE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 10-506 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, OF:
- (I) THE DAY, PLACE, AND TIME THAT THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MEET; AND
 - (II) THE CANCELLATION OF SCHEDULED MEETINGS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.

CHAPTER 325

(Senate Bill 598)

AN ACT concerning

Pensions - Disability Benefits

FOR the purpose of requiring that the retirement allowance of certain individuals retired for a disability from the State Police Retirement System, the Employees' Retirement System, and the Teachers' Retirement System be altered to a certain amount; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to disability retirement allowances for individuals retired from State Police, Employees', and Teachers' Retirement Systems of the State of Maryland.

BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,
