

6-303:

To apply for a mortician license, an applicant shall:

(1) Submit an application to the Board on the form that the Board requires; and

(2) Pay to the Board a license fee {of \$10} SET BY THE SECRETARY.

6-306:

(b) An applicant for an apprentice license shall pay to the Board a fee {of \$10} SET BY THE SECRETARY.

6-308:

(a) Subject to the provisions of this section, the Board shall issue a surviving spouse license to an applicant if the applicant:

(1) Is the surviving spouse of a licensed mortician who at the time of death was operating and wholly or partly owned a mortuary science business;

(2) Is not a licensed mortician;

(3) Submits to the Board, within 90 days of the death of the licensed mortician, the application required by the Board; and

(4) Pays every 2 years to the Board a license fee {of \$50} SET BY THE SECRETARY.

6-310:

(b) (1) To apply for a funeral establishment license, an applicant shall:

(i) Submit an application to the Board on the form that the Board requires; and

(ii) Pay to the Board an application fee {of \$25} SET BY THE SECRETARY.

6-313:

(c) Except as otherwise provided in this section, before a license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional 2-year term, if the licensee:

(1) Otherwise is entitled to be licensed;
