

(a) A license expires [every 2 years] ON THE LAST DAY OF THE BIRTH MONTH OF THE LICENSEE, unless the license is renewed for a [2] 1-year term as provided in this section.

(c) Before a license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional term, if the licensee:

(1) Otherwise is entitled to be licensed;

(2) Pays to the Board:

(i) A renewal fee ~~of \$20 \$12~~ SET BY THE SECRETARY; or

(ii) A renewal fee of not more than \$2 that is set by the ~~Board~~ SECRETARY if the licensee certifies to the Board that the licensee provides professional services only as a volunteer; and

(3) Submits to the Board a renewal application on the form that the Board requires.
