{ii}--A program approved by the Council on Education of the American Podiatry Association; or

{iii}--A program approved by the Board;

{3}--Submits an application to the Board on the form that the Board requires; and

{4}--Pays to the Board the application fee set by the {Board}-SECRETARY.

15-5-206.

{a}-{1}--{Except for the fees specifically set by this title, the Board}-THE SECRETARY may set reasonable fees for the issuance and renewal of certificates and {its}-other services PROVIDED BY THE BOARD.

{2}--The fees charged shall be set to produce funds so as to approximate the cost of maintaining the Board.

{3}--COST SHALL INCLUDE:

{i}--DOCUMENTED DIRECT COST, REGARDLESS OF WHERE BUDGETED; AND

{ii}--DOCUMENTED INDIRECT COST OF THE DEPARTMENT AND THE STATE.

{4}--THE SECRETARY MAY:

{i}--REVIEW AND SET FEES ANNUALLY;

{ii}--STANDARDIZE FEES FOR SIMILAR SERVICES; AND

{iii}--SUBMIT PROPOSED FEES AS PART OF THE BUDGETARY PROCESS.
