

{1}--Submit an application to the Board on the form that the Board requires; and

{2}--Pay to the Board the application fee set by the {Board}-SECRETARY.

{e}-{2}--The applicant shall pay to the Board a reexamination fee set by the {Board}-SECRETARY for each reexamination.

18-308.

{b}--At least 1 month before the license expires, the Board shall send to the licensee, by first class mail to the last known address of the licensee, a renewal notice that states:

{1}--The date on which the current license expires;

{2}--The date by which the renewal application must be received by the Board for the renewal to be issued and mailed before the license expires; and

{3}--The amount of the renewal fee SET BY THE SECRETARY.

{a}-{1}--{Except for the fees specifically set by this title, the Board shall} THE SECRETARY MAY set reasonable fees for the issuance and renewal of licenses and {its} other services PROVIDED BY THE BOARD.

{2}--The fees charged shall be set so as to produce funds to approximate the cost of maintaining the Board.

{3}--COST SHALL INCLUDE:

{I}--DOCUMENTED DIRECT COST, REGARDLESS OF WHERE BUDGETED; AND

{II}--DOCUMENTED INDIRECT COST OF THE DEPARTMENT AND THE STATE.

{4}--THE SECRETARY MAY:

{I}--REVIEW AND SET FEES ANNUALLY;

{II}--STANDARDIZE FEES FOR SIMILAR SERVICES; AND

{III}--SUBMIT PROPOSED FEES AS PART OF THE BUDGETARY PROCESS.
