Article 66B - Zoning and Planning

- (a) (1) The local legislative body may provide by ordinance for the enforcement of this article and of any ordinance or regulation made thereunder. A violation of this article or of such ordinance or regulation is a misdemeanor, and such local legislative body may provide for punishment by fine or imprisonment or both. It is also empowered to provide civil penalties for such violation.
- (2) IN ADDITION TO THE JURISDICTION AS DEFINED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF BALTIMORE COUNTY MAY ENFORCE-ITS-ZONING-REGULATIONS-BY-A-QUASI-JUBICIAL SYSTEM-THAT-MAY-PROVIDE-CIVIL PROVIDE BY ORDINANCE FOR AN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING TO ENFORCE ITS ZONING REGULATIONS, INCLUDING THE IMPOSITION OF CIVIL FINES AND PENALTIES FOR ZONING VIOLATIONS.
