- (c) The governing body of Washington County may grant, by law, a property tax credit under this section against the county property tax imposed on:
  - (1) property that is:
  - [(1)] (I) owned by a nonprofit civic association; and
- [(2)] (II) unless the compensation is used only to improve or maintain the property, used only for a community, civic, educational, or library purpose, if:
- [(i)] l. the use is not contingent on the payment of compensation for admission-to-or use of the property; and
- [(ii)] 2. unless the compensation is used only to improve or maintain the property, failure to pay compensation is not a reason to deny admission to or use of the property; AND
- (2) PERSONAL PROPERTY THAT IS OWNED BY MID-EAST MILK LAB SERVICES, INCORPORATED.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
