- (B) (1) A RESIDENTIAL FACILITY FOR CHILDREN SHALL MAINTAIN CONTRACTS OR OTHER AGREEMENT AGREEMENTS WITH AN A--CONTRACT APPROPRIATE HEALTH CARE PROVIDER PROVIDERS TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING HEALTH CARE SERVICES FOR EACH CHILD WHO RESIDES IN THE FACILITY FOR MORE THAN 30 CONSECUTIVE DAYS:
- (I) A PHYSICAL EXAMINATION AND NECESSARY MEDICAL TREATMENT; AND
  - (II) APPROPRIATE MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES.
- (2) WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER A CHILD IS PLACED IN A RESIDENTIAL FACILITY FOR CHILDREN THE RESIDENTIAL FACILITY SHALL ENSURE THAT A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER SHABE:
- (I) CONDUCTS A PHYSICAL EXAMINATION OF THE CHILD; AND
- (II) PROVIDE PROVIDES A REPORT ON THE FINDINGS OF THE EXAMINATION TO THE RESIDENTIAL FACILITY FOR CHILDREN WHERE THE CHILD RESIDES.
- (C) (1) UPON THE FINDING OF A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION, A RESIDENTIAL FACILITY FOR CHILDREN THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION SHALL BE FINED \$25 PER DAY PER CHILD FOR EACH DAY THAT THE VIOLATION EXISTS.
- (2) IF A FINE IS IMPOSED ON A RESIDENTIAL FACILITY FOR CHILDREN, THE DIRECTOR-7- OR THE ADMINISTRATOR7-AND-MEMBERS OF-THE-BOARD-OF-DIRECTORS OF THE RESIDENTIAL FACILITY FOR CHILDREN MAY BE LIABLE FOR PAYMENT OF THE FINE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
