CHAPTER 405

(House Bill 428)

AN ACT concerning

Public Ethics - Conflicts of Laws -Law Enforcement Officers' Bill of Rights

FOR the purpose of clarifying that the requirements of the Law Enforcement Officers' Bill of Rights do not apply to the activities of the State Ethics Commission carried out under the Public Ethics Law.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 40A - Maryland Public Ethics Law Section 1-103 Annotated Code of Maryland (1986 Replacement Volume and 1987 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 40A - Maryland Public Ethics Law

1-103.

- (A) Other provisions of law or regulations relating to conflicts of interest, financial disclosure, or lobbying disclosure shall apply where the provisions of those laws or regulations are more stringent than this article.
- (B) THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 27, §§ 727 THROUGH 734D OF THE CODE DO NOT APPLY TO THE ACTIVITIES CARRIED OUT BY THE STATE ETHICS COMMISSION UNDER THIS ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
