SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

9-204.

(a) This section applies [only] to any water supply system, sewerage system, or refuse disposal system that is for public use ~~OR ANY REFUSE DISPOSAL SYSTEM, AS DEFINED BY APPLICABLE REGULATIONS, TO BE INSTALLED, ALTERED, OR EXTENDED AFTER JULY 1, 1988,~~ OR ANY REFUSE DISPOSAL SYSTEM THAT IS A SOLID WASTE ACCEPTANCE FACILITY AS DEFINED IN § 9-501(N) OF THIS TITLE IF THE SOLID WASTE ACCEPTANCE FACILITY IS INSTALLED, ALTERED, OR EXTENDED AFTER JULY 1, 1988.

The Secretary may not issue a permit to install, materially alter, or materially extend a [landfill] REFUSE DISPOSAL SYSTEM REGULATED UNDER § 9-204(A) OF THIS SUBTITLE until{:

(1) The landfill meets all zoning and land use requirements of the county where the landfill is or is to be located; and

(2) The] THE Department has a written statement FROM THE APPLICANT [that the board of county commissioners or the county council of the county where the landfill is to be located does not oppose the issuance of the permit] THAT THE REFUSE
