- (v) increases the number of Blacks, Asians, and other nonwhites in management and supervisory positions; and
- (vi) improves the quality of employees' lives outside the work environment in such areas as housing, transportation, schooling, recreation, and health facilities.

In any solicitation, a -f-unit-j- PUBLIC-BODY shall provide notice of the requirements of this subtitle.

The Board OR-THE-COUNTY-GOVERNING-BODY may waive the requirements of § 14-502, § 14-503, or § 14-504 of this subtitle if the Board OR-THE-COUNTY-GOVERNING-BODY finds that:

- (1) the procurement is essential or in the best interests of the -{-State-}- PUBLEC-BODY; and
- (2) there is no other known source for the procurement at a reasonable cost.

A bidder or offeror may not misrepresent any information contained in the certification required under this subtitle.

14-507.

A bidder or offeror who willfully violates any provision of this subtitle is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 3 months.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1988.
