- (2) The reimbursement rate may differ between homes and institutions that provide intermediate services, as defined by the Department, and homes and institutions that provide full services.
- (C) THE DEPARTMENT, OR THE DEPARTMENT'S DESIGNEE, MAY NOT PLACE A CHILD IN A RESIDENTIAL GROUP HOME OR OTHER FACILITY THAT IS NOT OPERATING IN COMPLIANCE WITH 60CA6-AND-STATE APPLICABLE STATE LICENSING LAWS.

## Article - Health - General

7-1101.

- (a) (1) Unless licensed by the Administration under this title, a person may not provide the following services to an individual with developmental disability or to a recipient of individual support services, as defined in § 7-901 of this title:
  - [(1)] (I) Day habilitation services;
  - [(2)] (II) Residential services;
  - [(3)] (III) Services coordination;
  - [(4)] (IV) Vocational services;
- [(5)] (V) More than 1 family support service, as defined in § 7-701 of this title; and
  - [(6)] (VI) More than 1 individual support service.
- (2) THE ADMINISTRATION, THE ADMINISTRATION'S DESIGNEE, OR AN AGENCY THAT RECEIVES PUBLIC FUNDS MAY NOT PLACE AN INDIVIDUAL IN A RESIDENTIAL GROUP HOME OR OTHER FACILITY THAT IS NOT OPERATING IN COMPLIANCE WITH 600A6-AND-STATE APPLICABLE STATE LICENSING LAWS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
