Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages License - Seasonal Use

FOR the purpose of including Harford County in the provisions of law that authorize a seasonal use of an alcoholic beverages license under certain circumstances; ~~and authorizing the Harford County Liquor Control Board to adopt regulations for a certain purpose.~~

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

(e) (1) [In Wicomico County, if] IF the WICOMICO COUNTY board of license commissioners OR THE HARFORD COUNTY LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD determines that a licensed premise UNDER ITS JURISDICTION is seasonally operated, the RESPECTIVE COUNTY board may authorize the closing of the premises IN ITS RESPECTIVE JURISDICTION for no more than 6 months.

(2) To qualify for this exception[, the]:

(I) THE licensee shall submit a written request to the RESPECTIVE COUNTY board [of license commissioners] at least 30 days before the anticipated date of closing; AND

(II) IN HARFORD COUNTY, THE LICENSEE SHALL ALSO SUBMIT A WRITTEN REQUEST TO THE BOARD AT LEAST 30 DAYS BEFORE THE ANTICIPATED DATE OF REOPENING.
